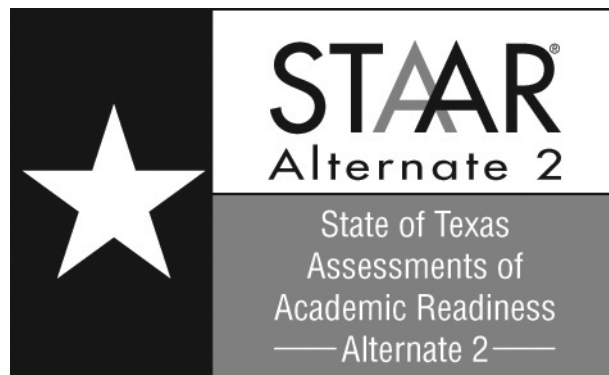

## Overview

STAAR Grades 3–8 and STAAR Alternate 2 Grades 3–8 results are reported separately. However, the file format for STAAR Grades 3–8 and STAAR Alternate 2 Grades 3–8 are the same for fields that are the same on both assessments. For example, fields like the ECONOMIC-DISADVANTAGE-CODE and SCORE CODES (and many others) will be found in the same positions on both files.

Following is a list of the most significant changes being implemented in 2017.

- The FALL 2016 PEIMS MILITARY-CONNECTED-STUDENT-CODE and NEW TO TEXAS fields have been added to the Other Student Information section (see positions 164 and 190 respectively).
- On-Track Measure has been added for reading and mathematics to report on track to achieve Level II: Satisfactory Academic Performance (see positions 429 for reading and 782 for mathematics).
- Because the STAAR Alternate 2 assessments are not being released in 2017, item reporting category numbers (see positions 451-470 for reading, 801-820 for mathematics, 1201-1220 for writing, 1601-1620 for social studies, and 2001-2010 for science) and student responses (see positions 503-522 for reading, 857-876 for mathematics, 1241-1260 for writing, 1653-1672 for social studies, and 2055-2074 for science) have been removed.
- Removed the Photocopy or Cut Out Accommodation (see positions 653 for reading, 1003 for mathematics, 1403 for writing, 1803 for social studies, and 2203 for science).
- STAAR Alternate 2 Progress Measure fields have been added to the previous-year history information (see positions 2554 for reading and 2674 for mathematics).

NOTE: The data will be provided in a fixed-length text file format with the layout defined below. The file extension will be .dat.

## Attention For Users of Tab-delimited Files

If you ordered a tab-delimited file, a delimiter has been placed after each data field in the file (Hex = 09). The field order is the same as contained in the format below, but the field positions do not apply. The tab-delimited file does not contain a header row.
